Charge Conference approves next steps for Cornerstone – We are excited to be moving forward with construction on our second floor space! Charge conference approved increasing the Cornerstone budget from \$700,000 (approved in 2019) to \$1,060,000 (approved last night). The increase in budget will allow us to install the necessary fire protection (a hybrid of sprinklers and fire barriers), which will make the entire church safer, and the best part – it will enable us to open our second floor for youth and community programming in 2021!
